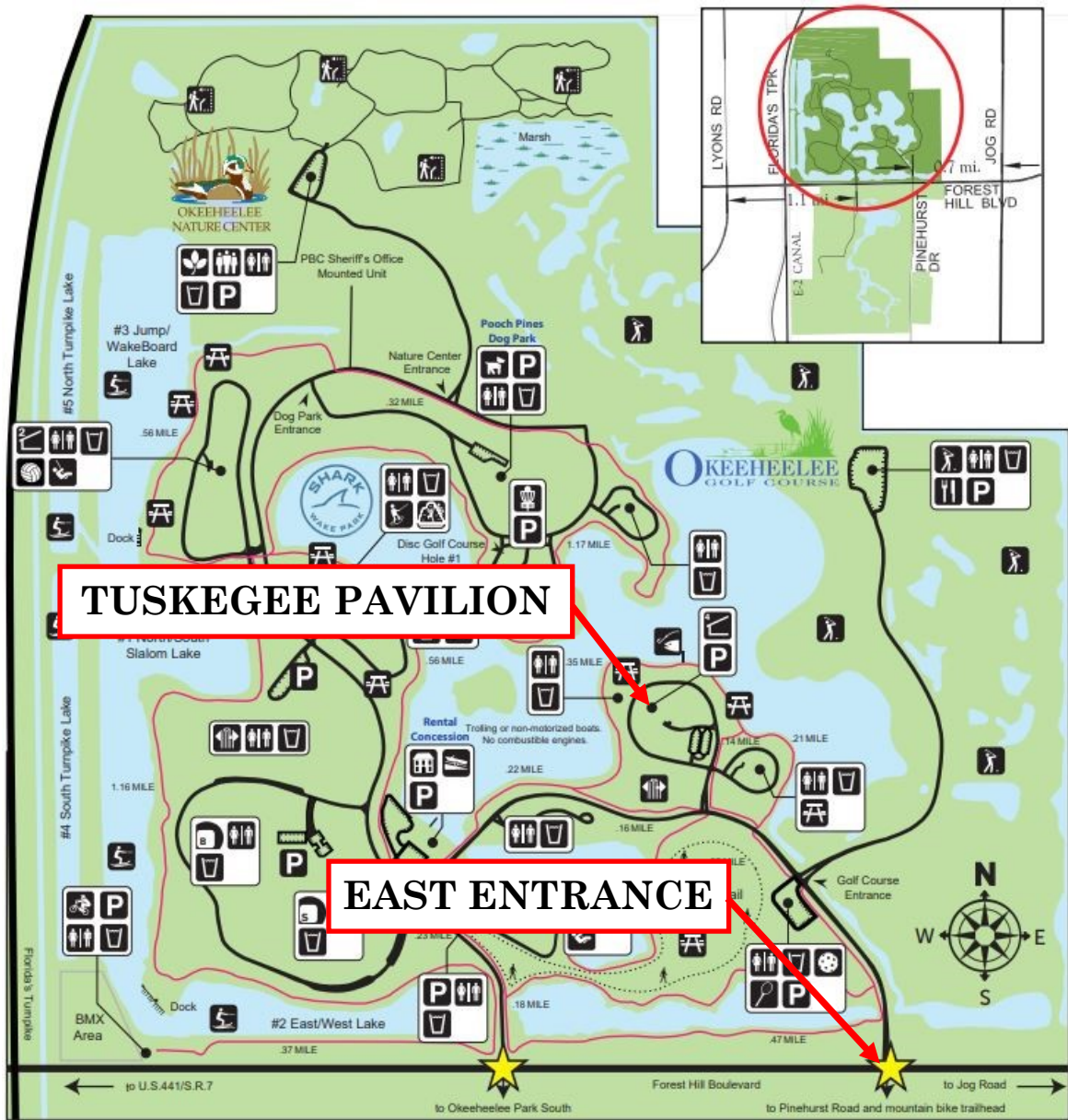
We will be taking RSVPs at the meeting.
