The 2021 Gold Coast Treasure Club Holiday Party will be Saturday December 4, 2021. It will be at the same pavilion in Okeeheelee park.

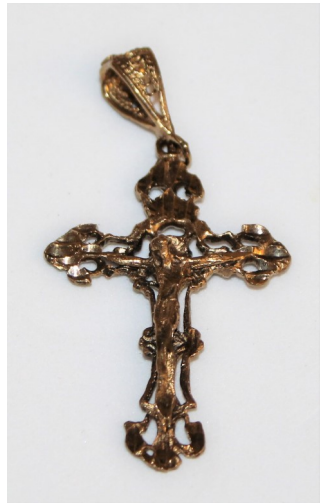
We will be discussing more at the meeting, so if you have any questions, or ideas to help make the party fun, please bring them up.

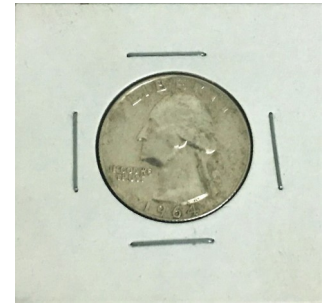

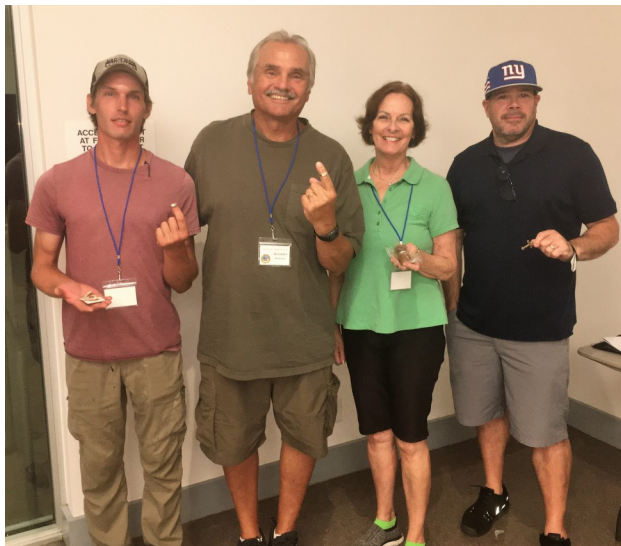
