Bring your detectors.

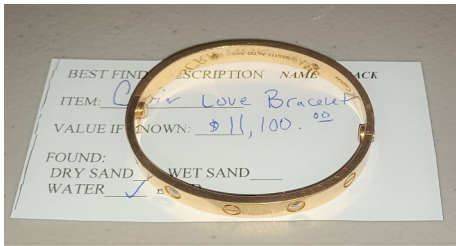

There will also be a discussion about tuning your machine to find targets in specific environments.

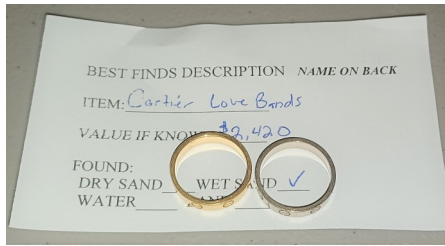

Florida Statute 375.251

When asking for permission to detect someone's property, one common reason given for not allowing anyone on the property is that they don't want to get sued if someone is hurt. As long as the property owner/lessee is not charging for admission to the area, they are not liable. Florida Statute 375.251 spells out all of the details, but the bottom line is that, as long as the owner of the area is not charging admission, an owner or lessee:

1. Is not presumed to extend any assurance that the area is safe for any purpose;
2. Does not incur any duty of care toward a person who goes on the area;
3. Is not liable or responsible for any injury to persons or property caused by the act or omission of a person who goes on the area.
