April Best Finds

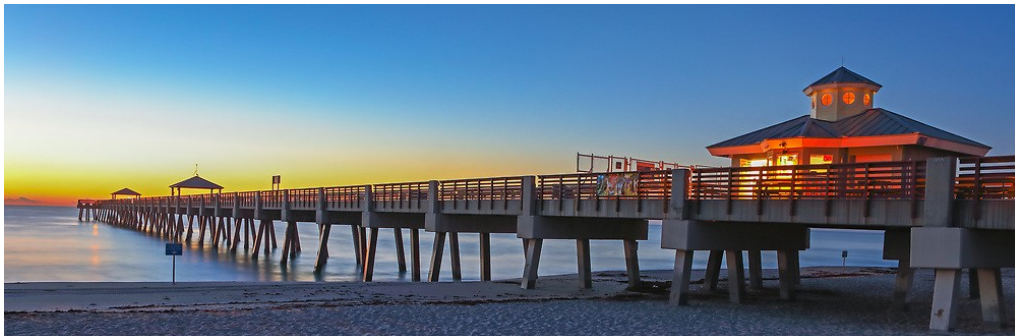


It was the Alfredo and JLP III show at last month's meeting.
