Wear nylon suit under dive suit.

Wear water dive shoes.

Wear a good pair of gloves.

Wear a hat that covers your face and use sunscreen.

Wear a mask to protect your eyes.

Have a stainless steel clip on your belt to clip digger so that both hands are free.

Keep track of your partner as they should do the same for you.

Start out wading to waist deep water. When more experienced, wade up to your neck with mask on.

If going deep, you need to use weights.

Beware of riptides!

When back on dry land, shower with FSLS naptha soap.
