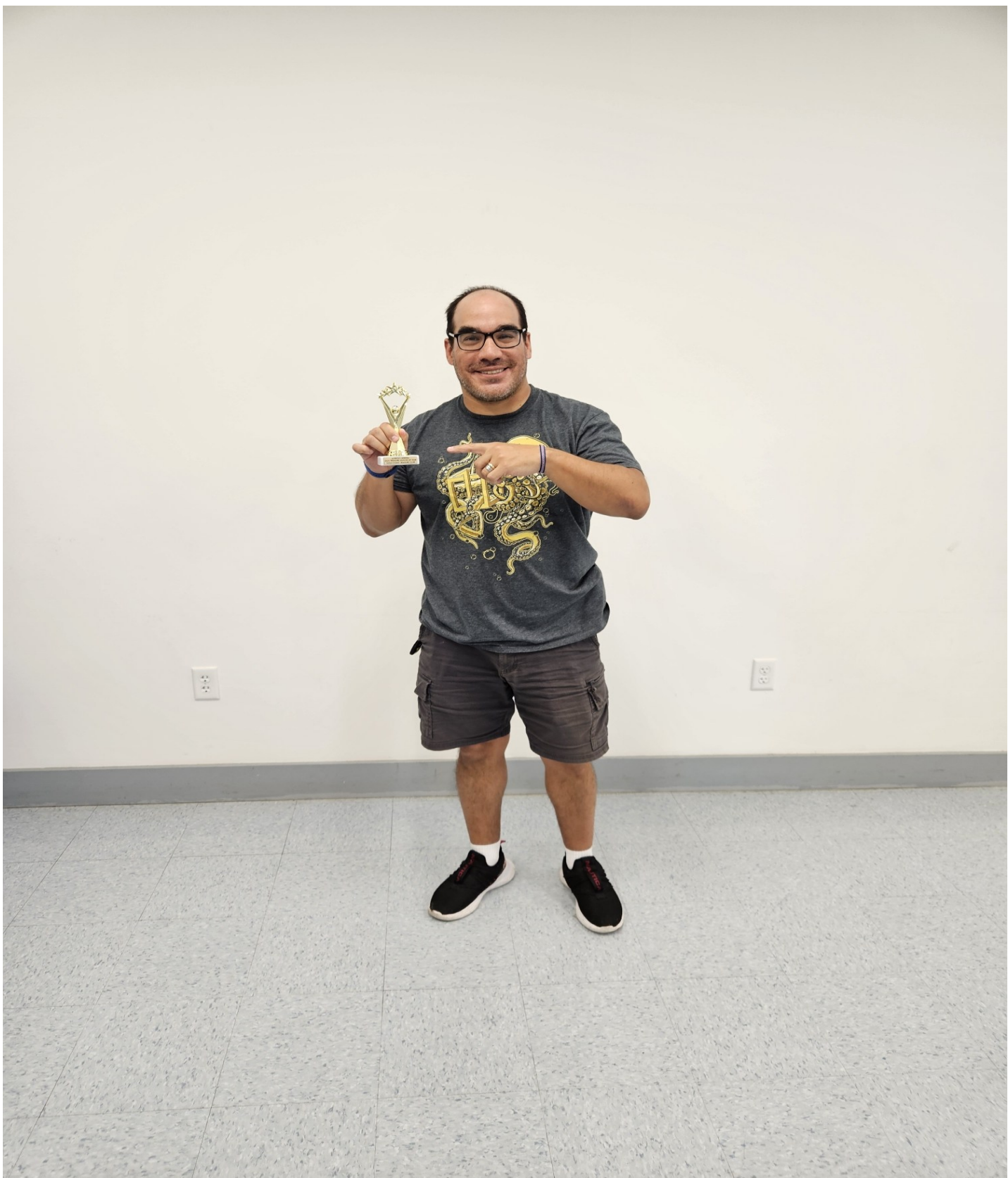
Treasure Coast Archeological Society will be doing their annual hunt on the second Saturday of March (March 14, 2026). The seeded hunts are in the Vero Beach area.

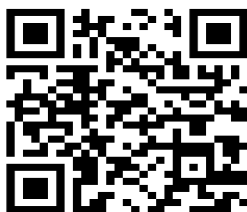
Do you have your club pin yet? These pins are 3 inches across. A nice addition to any t-shirt, cap, or detector bag.
