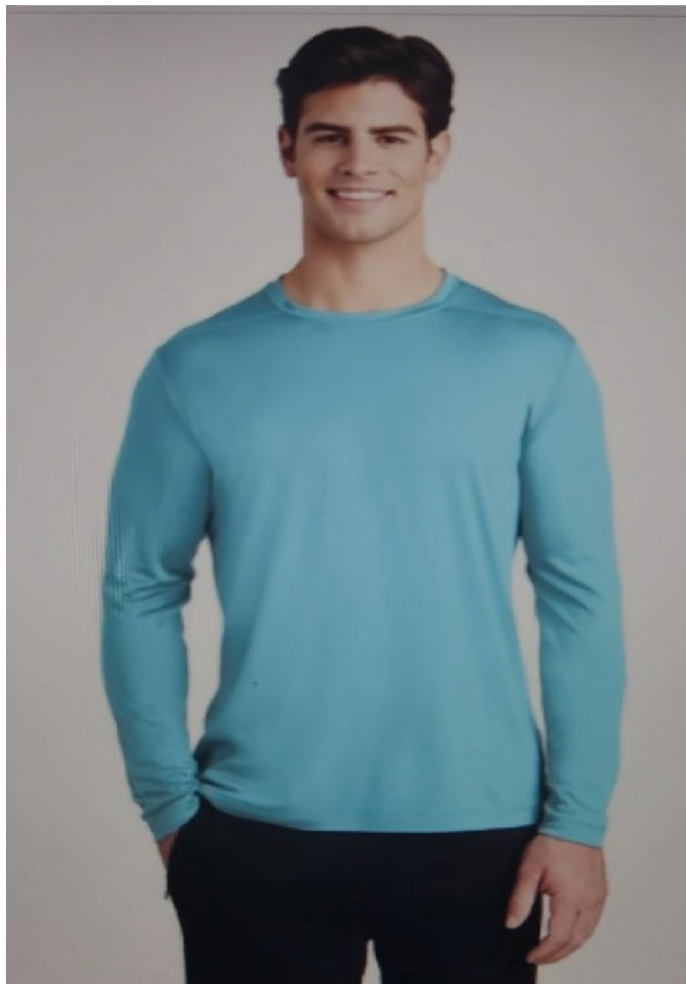
## CLUB SHIRTS FOR SALE

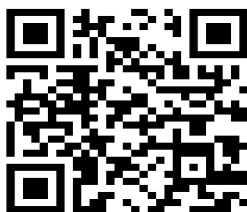
Do you have your club pin yet? These pins are 3 inches across. A nice addition to any t-shirt, cap, or detector bag.
